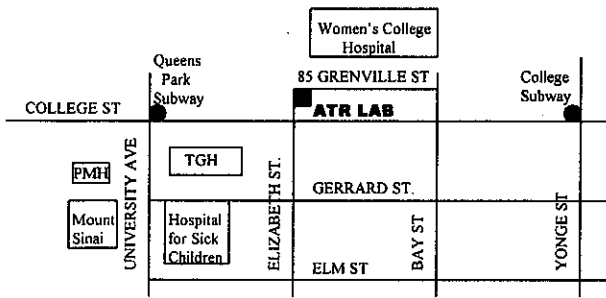

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATIENT PREPARATION:**

**PREPARATION FOR ABDOMINAL ULTRASOUND**

1. Morning Appointment: Nothing by mouth after midnight. No Breakfast.
2. Afternoon Appointment: On morning of examination drink clear fluids. May eat food not containing fat or dairy products. Nothing by mouth after breakfast.

3. Abdominal Ultrasound for Blood in Urine:
  4. Abdominal + Pelvic Ultrasound:
- } ⇒ #1 OR #2 as above PLUS drink 20 ounces of water 1 hour prior to examination.

Note: You may take medications as usual.

**PREPARATION FOR PELVIC ULTRASOUND/OBSTETRICAL ULTRASOUND < 4 MONTHS**

1. Finish drinking 20 ounces (~ 2 cups) of fluid at least 1 hour prior to appointment time (do NOT need to be uncomfortably full).

**PREPARATION FOR TRANSVAGINAL/TRANSRECTAL ULTRASOUND ONLY:**

1. Laxative of choice 24 hours before procedure.
2. Arrive with a mildly full bladder for the ultrasound.
3. For Prostate Ultrasound: PSA blood test should be done before ultrasound and results should be brought with you at time of your ultrasound

**VAGINAL SONOHYSTEROGRAM:**

Advil -- 2 tablets 1 hour before procedure  
 (Please advise secretary at time of booking if you have a history of heart disease)

**ALL OTHER EXAMINATIONS – NO PREPARATION**

 (A fee will be charged for missed appointments or cancellation without notice)
